Artist description:

Michel Mouffe's sculptural paintings are composed of thin layers of glaze. As a result of the subtle colour vibrations that Mouffe uses, the paintings suggest an unbounded space. Subtle bulges emerge from the interior of the canvas that seem to have a pulsating effect.
