Artist description:

After studying art history and working as a collections manager at the Museum of Contemporary Art in Antwerp (M HKA) Bert De Beul decided to devote his career to painting. Furthermore, his images are composed in such a way that part of the painting has to be imagined. This is also the reason why De Beul's works hardly have any title.
